



Dog License Application

A License is required for dogs over 3 months of age. Licensing helps the City insure that dogs are properly vaccinated against rabies. It also helps the City and Animal Control identify lost animals, returning them to their owners, saving the cost of taking them to a shelter. The City of Little Canada allows three pets per household (dogs/cats).

- **Leash**—Dogs must be on a leash and under your control at all times when not on your property.
- **Pick Up**—Pet waste must be cleaned up in your yard and on walks and must be disposed of in a proper container.
- **Barking**—Dogs cannot unreasonably disturb the peace with barking. More regulations pertaining to dogs can be found on our website at www.littlecanadamn.org, Section 1101 of Little Canada's Municipal Code.

LICENSE IS VALID FOR 2 YEARS FROM DATE OF ISSUE

- **Rabies Vaccination**— Proof of current rabies vaccination is required to obtain a dog license. Once licensed, if the vaccination expires before the license, the owner is responsible for promptly renewing the vaccination and providing the city with a copy of the new certificate.
- **License Fee:** (cash or check payable to City of Little Canada)
\$20 non-spayed/neutered
\$15 spayed/neutered....proper documentation is required, unless already on file with the City.
